




Attendance

Keeping your scheduled appointment is the most important thing you can do to achieve a good outcome. Please make every effort to come to your scheduled appointments.

Speak with your therapist about your specific scheduling requirements. We'll do our best to schedule convenient appointment times.

Cancellation and "no-show" policies

If you must cancel or change your appointment, please call us at 617-754-9100, at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled appointment time. This allows us to offer the appointment time to another patient in need.



- cancels and reschedules three appointments within a 30-day period, or
- does not show up for two visits within a 30-day period.

What to wear to appointments

Please wear loose-fitting casual clothing that allows you to move comfortably, and is easy to remove and change. We suggest wearing shorts for leg or back treatments.

Your first visit and at-home exercises

Your therapist will perform a comprehensive exam, and work with you to develop your unique treatment plan, based on your needs and goals. You'll also discuss the frequency and timing of follow-up visits. Follow-up visits often range from 1-3 times per week, for a defined period of time. Most patients reach their treatment goals in 6-8 appointments.

Part of your treatment plan will include exercises to complete at home. Your personalized home



program will have easy-to-follow printed instructions with pictures. We'll thoroughly review the instructions with you during your visit, and you'll have time to ask any questions. If you have any questions when you're home, please call us at **617-754-9100**.



Free and convenient parking

The most convenient parking lot is in the Carl J. Shapiro Clinical Center parking garage. We provide up to 3 hours of free parking at this garage during the time of your visit. Please make sure you bring your parking ticket to your appointment so we can validate it.

Insurance

We accept most third party insurance plans. If you have questions about your particular insurance coverage, please call the number on the back of your insurance card. Most insurance companies require a co-payment at the time of your visit. Please pay your copayment at each visit. We accept cash, personal checks, and major credit cards.

More about insurance coverage

Here's how the process usually works. Most healthcare insurance plans require prior approval/authorization for our services in order for them to pay the cost of their share of the services, as outlined in the details of your coverage. A physician order is also required.

After your first appointment and complete evaluation, we submit a written treatment plan to your insurance company. Your insurance company reviews it and makes a decision about approving the plan we recommended. Most insurance companies require up to 72 hours to review the information and make a decision about approving the plan. We'll make every effort to help move the insurance approval process along from our end.

Please contact one of our managed care coordinators the day before your scheduled second appointment if you are unsure about whether your insurance company approved your coverage. You may reach managed care coordinator Joanne Kinlaw at 617-667-9243, and managed care coordinator Sandra Andrade at 617-667-9262.

You have two options if an approval from your insurance company has not been received yet. You could cancel the appointment and wait for us to receive the approval to schedule another appointment, or you could sign an insurance waiver form that says if the approval does not

eventually come through from your insurance company, you agree to pay for the full cost of the visit yourself. We understand this process may seem daunting, and we'll do everything we can to help navigate it.

Locations

In addition to Boston, there are many other convenient locations where our therapists are available to see patients for different types of therapies. If you prefer to be seen by a therapist at another location, ask your therapist if there might be someone who could help you at that site.




