






# **Fragility Vertebral Compression Fractures**



## **CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS**

### **Patient Presentation:**

- > 60 yo
- Low mechanism injury
- New pain / tenderness
- Absence of new neurologic findings

Spine Center Evaluation by Non-operative Provider



### Radiologic factors to document:

after 2-3 months

X-ray = compression fracture

# TREATMENT Pain control Mobilization Avoid lifting / sustained forward bending until pain resolves or 2–3 months Brace not required MRI not required MRI not required 1–2 weeks Failure to mobilize due to pain, or ↑ pain Activity as tolerated
