Posterior Spinal Fusion Pathway	Multidisciplinary effort that developed a clinical pathway for elective posterior spinal fusion. Goal of effort is to increase communication, transparency, safety, and decrease variation in care. Presented at the Silverman Institute, BIDMC
The Spine Center @ BIDMC	The Spine Center @ BIDMC is a multidisciplinary, academic, tertiary care center that includes (neurosurgery, orthopedic spine surgery, anesthesia pain, physical medicine and rehabilitation, neurology, and physical therapy).
