The community health centers affiliated with Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center came together in 1997 to form a partnership called Community Care Alliance (CCA), supporting their efforts to provide the highest quality, most cost-effective services possible while maintaining their organizational independence. Each health center is unique in terms of size, populations served and services provided, reflecting the rich racial, ethnic, and cultural diversity of the communities in which they are located. Physicians are BIDMC-credentialed, and most are affiliated with Harvard Medical School. All of our health centers bring BIDMC specialists and residents on-site to offer specialty programs including infectious disease, neurology, OB/GYN, gastroenterology, pulmonary and surgical consultations.

The CCA health centers ensure health care access for our communities' most vulnerable patients, offering culturally responsive community-based primary care and social services. Through CCA, we are able to create effective initiatives to foster healthy communities.

- Evening and weekend hours
- Health benefit enrollment
- Social services counseling
- Care in multiple languages
- Services regardless of ability to pay

- On-site laboratory

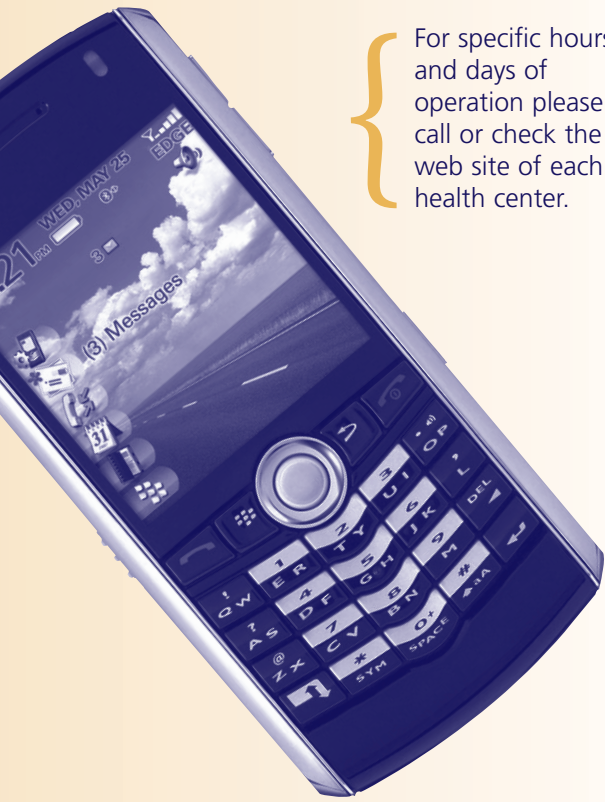

The Sidney Borum, Jr. Health Center, affectionately known as the Borum, is a program of Fenway Health that provides safe, non-judgmental care for young people ages 12-29 who may not feel comfortable going anywhere else. Patients include teens and young adults who are LGBT or questioning, those living with HIV/AIDS, young women, and young people who are gang-involved, living on the streets or don't have health insurance. No one is turned away. The Borum is a licensed health center, mental health clinic and substance abuse center.
