Atrial fibrillation is a condition where the atrium of the heart does not beat normally. Blood can pool in the atrium because it does not contract with a strong squeeze. Blood clots can form and travel to other places in the body. Blood thinning (anticoagulant) medications like Coumadin (Warfarin) can decrease the risk of a blood clot forming.
