

## Researchers at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center are conducting a research study to learn about celiac disease.

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### This study may be a good fit for you if...

- You have been diagnosed with celiac disease
- You are between 18 and 70 years old
- You are following a gluten-free diet for at least 12 months

### If you decide to take part in the research study, you would...

- Undergo a 13-day gluten challenge
  - Have blood draws, genetic testing for celiac disease and 1 upper endoscopy with duodenal biopsies
  - It will involve 5 outpatient visits to BIDMC, ~2 months participation from the first to the last study visit
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### About the research study

1. The research will take place at the **Clinical Research Center** at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center.
2. All study procedures will be covered by our study fund and of **no cost** to you.
3. To compensate for time and travel, participants will receive **\$1,250** in addition to travel and parking reimbursement.
4. The Principal Investigator is **Dr. Ciaran Kelly**.
